

**CALL FOR NOMINATIONS**  
**Faculty Award for University Undergraduate Research**  
**Office of Undergraduate Studies & University Research Services & Administration**

The second annual **Georgia State Undergraduate Research Conference (GSURC)** will be held on Friday, March 14, 2008, in the Student Center. As part of the preparation for this exciting event, the advisory board of GSURC is currently soliciting nominations for the Faculty Award for Undergraduate Research. The award recipient will receive \$2000 and will serve as the Keynote Speaker for the 2008 GSURC.

The successful nominee for the Faculty Award for Undergraduate Research must be a full-time Georgia State faculty member with a demonstrated commitment to mentoring and supporting undergraduate students in research activities. Evidence of research collaboration with undergraduates, including co-authorship of conference presentations and/or peer-reviewed publications, is strongly encouraged.

Nominations may come from any member of the Georgia State community. Nominations should be sent by **January 4** in the form of an email message to [gsurc@gsu.edu](mailto:gsurc@gsu.edu) with an attachment containing the following:

- Name of nominator (person submitting letter),
- Contact information,
- Relationship to nominee, and
- A one page statement indicating what characteristics of the nominee show his or her commitment and facilitation of undergraduate research.

The nominee must also submit an email by **January 4** to [gsurc@gsu.edu](mailto:gsurc@gsu.edu) with two attachments containing the following information:

- Name of nominee,
- Contact information,
- A summary of his or her involvement with undergraduate research, including activities with undergraduate students,
- Indications of the success of their undergraduate students' research (e.g., presentations, awards, publications, graduate school), and
- A curriculum vita.

The deadline for nominations is Friday, January 4, 2007. Incomplete nominations will not be considered. Nomination materials will be reviewed by the GSURC Advisory Board with the final decision being announced January 18, 2007.
