





RED DOT – GETTING STARTED

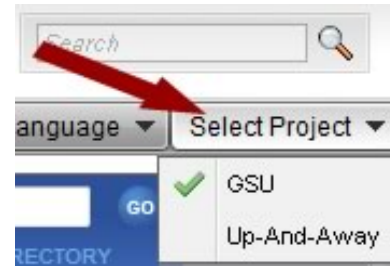
Red Dot is a Windows based content management software. Red Dot will NOT work on a Mac unless a Windows operating system has been installed on it using Parallels, Boot Camp, Fusion, etc. Log in credentials for Red Dot are NOT the same as your other campus credentials. To get log in credentials for Red Dot, please e-mail help@gsu.edu and request them. Once you have your username and password go to <http://reddot.gsu.edu/CMS> to log in. NOTE: Red Dot uses pop-ups for many things. Be sure to enable pop-ups for the Red Dot site so you will have full functionality.

You can use the following browsers to update your content:

- MS Internet Explorer version 6 (Windows operating system) and later
 - Firefox version 3.0 (platform-independent) and later
 - Safari version 3.1 (Apple/Macintosh, Windows operating system) and later
- Web Masters have to use MS Internet Explorer to access advanced functionalities.

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Once in Red Dot you can change your password by clicking on the Settings button	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• And then on User Settings	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• In the screen that comes up change any information that is appropriate and click OK (lower right) to save your changes.	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• When you're returned to the home screen, go into the SmartEdit area. You'll know you are in the SmartEdit area if the SmartEdit tab is a lighter color than the others.	

- Now, go to the Select Project button on the right hand side and select the project you are going to be working in.



- To get to the page you need to edit, navigate through the site like you would any other web page
