# Attention Turner Field Parkers

The Atlanta Braves' 2009 season begins April 10, 2009. Home games played at Turner Field will affect the Georgia State BLUE LOT parking in two ways:


When the Braves play an early game (before 5:00 p.m.), the parking lot will be closed to Georgia State University students. The following are the dates affected:
