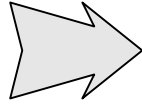


CUTS (LACERATIONS) RECOMMENDED GUIDELINES

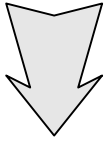
Is there a possibility of damage to major blood vessels or nerves? Are you bleeding profusely? Lost a body part? Cut to bone?

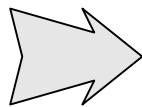
May be time for a trip to the Emergency Room. Then file a Workers' Compensation (WC) Claim.

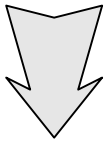
Is there pus, extensive redness, swelling or fever?

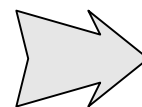
File a WC Claim and seek medical attention, immediately!

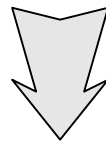
Can the edges of the wound be brought together easily?

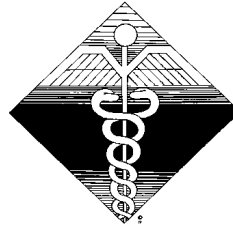
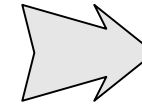
File a WC Claim and seek medical attention, quickly to minimize scarring!

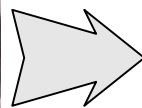
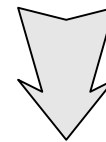
Is the cut on the face, chest, abdomen, back or palm of hand?
