TRANSIENT STUDENT

A Transient Student is a visiting student completing courses in a degree program at another accredited college or university.

You must request from the registrar at your home institution an official statement of permission to register as a transient student.

Transient enrollment is valid for one fall or spring semester only, but for unlimited summer semesters. Financial aid is not typically available. A new application fee and official statement of permission to register are required for each additional desired term.

POSTBACCALAUREATE

A Postbaccalaureate is an applicant who has received a bachelor's degree and does not wish to pursue a second bachelor's degree.

You must submit an official transcript from the degree-granting institution verifying the award of a bachelor's degree. Postbaccalaureate status is not available in the College of Education.

An applicant seeking teacher certification in an area other than art or music must apply as a transfer student. Applicants to nursing, nutrition, and respiratory therapy must apply as transfer students. Financial aid is not typically available.

APPLICATION DEADLINES

All necessary credentials should be received no later than 15 days after the application is received.

APPLICATION CHECK LIST

- Prior to submitting your application, attach a nonrefundable application processing fee (check or money order) made payable to Georgia State University.
- Verify your social security number. While provision of your social security number is required (if applicable), an alternative identification number (Panther #) will be assigned to you as your primary means of identification. You will use your Panther # to access our student information system (GoSOLAR) and check the status of your application. The social security number is important for helping match your application with financial aid information, test scores, and any other documents you may submit. If you do not have a social security number, leave the space blank.
