

ISSS TRAVEL REMINDERS

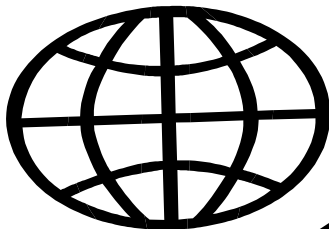


Make sure you have the following items with you when you travel:

1. **Passport & U.S. visa**
(passport must be valid for at least 6 months)
2. **Visitors Visa to any country you may be transiting or visiting**
3. **Signed I-20**
4. **Georgia State University transcript**
(ask Registrar's Office)
5. **New financial documents**
(bank statements, GRA letter, etc.)
6. **EAD card and proof of employment (if on OPT)**

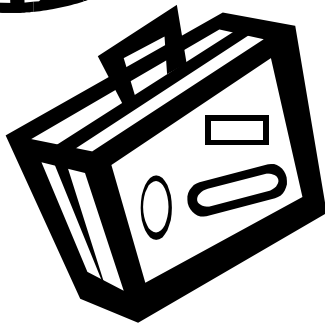
1. You may be asked for these documents by immigration at the airport.

If you will be applying for a visa, expect serious delays. Contact the embassy to ask the estimated time it will take. Also if you have questions about the process meet with an advisor before travelling.



Once you return to the U.S., come to International Services a.s.a.p. so that we may copy your new I-94 card (and new visa if applicable).

Note: If your I-94 card has "FIN #" or "NSEERS" written on it, you are responsible for going through a check-out procedure when you leave the United States.
