

Applying for Housing– Academic year: FALL 2008/SPRING 2009

Step 1

Beginning February 4, you may submit an on-line University Housing Room Reservation request. You must be accepted to Georgia State University before submitting a Housing Reservation application.

Step 2

Obtain your campus ID and email by visiting <https://www.student.gsu.edu/> and click ***Network Account / Getting Started***

Step 3

Complete your housing application online at <https://housing.gsu.edu/applyonline>.

Step 4

The room reservation fee (\$525) will post to your Student Account. If you do not see the \$525 Room Reservation fee on your student account in 48 hours, please contact the University Housing Office at 404-413-1800. Once the fee posts, you may choose the following:

1. Submit credit card (MC, AmEx, and Discover) and web check payments online using GoSolar

Select GoSolar
Login to GoSolar--- Enter your User ID# and your PIN#
Select - Student Account Menu
Select - Pay Tuition & Fees
2. Pay in person with cash, check/money order at Student Accounts, 100 Sparks Hall

Step 5

Returning and New Residents - **Beginning March 17, 2008**, please check back to let us know who you prefer to room with. The last day to make roommate preferences is **May 30, 2008**. Preferences made after this date may not be considered in time for room assignments.

Returning and New Residents – **On June 2, 2008**, please check back to see your room assignment based on the preferences you provided. Housing will be assigned based on availability and the preferences you made on your application.

Step 6

All students under the age of 18 will need to print out the Housing Contract and turn it into the Housing Office signed by both the student and a parent/legal guardian.
