

Admission Deadlines

Application deadlines must be followed according to each student admission type. The \$60 application fee is non-refundable, but may be applied toward any of the two terms immediately following the term for which a student initially applied. The three terms in an academic year are fall, spring, and summer.

If you wish to change your term of entry to one of the two terms immediately following the term for which you initially applied, you must complete a reactivation form; if you wish to postpone your entry to any later terms, you must submit a new application and new application fee.
